## FLO IMPACT

#### **FLO INDUSTRIAL PARK**

1st 100% Women-Owned Industrial Park in India at Hyderabad Facilitated by FLO Hyderabad

World over, investing in women is recognised as crucial to achieving sustainable development. As the apex body and voice of industry, FICCI Ladies Organisation (FLO) is at the forefront of the Make in India endeavour that supports sustainable growth. With the State & Central Government, as its partners in progress, FLO has been relentlessly working for, and promoting, Women's Economic Empowerment at all levels.

On a global average, women constitute 30% of the industrial labour force. However, Indian women in manufacturing account for only 20% of the total workforce. A study conducted by McKinsey stated that India could increase its GDP by 16% to 60% just by enabling women to participate in the economy on the same footing as men, especially in the manufacturing sector.

With the strong belief that increasing women's presence and participation in the manufacturing sector is a true contribution to economic growth, Jyotsna Angara, the Chapter Chairperson of Hyderabad Chapter in 2013, envisioned the establishing of the FLO Industrial Park in the city. This was planned with an aim to increase and promote FLO members' presence in the MSME Sector. The Chapter took up the responsibility to conceptualise, facilitate and implement the setting up of the 1st 100% women-owned industrial park, thereby sparking a new wave of entrepreneurship.

FLO, FICCI and Govt. of Telangana, signed an MoU to allot 50 acres land at Sultanpur, Hyderabad for the development of a state-of-the-art Industrial Park exclusively for FLO members. All applications for approval to various departments were submitted through the Telangana government single clearance window for industrial permissions. This one-stop portal helped allottees obtain all the necessary permissions to set up their respective industries in a hassle-free manner. Another unique feature was that any application that was not reviewed and approved within 10 days was deemed approved on the 11th day. These deadlines helped speed up action on the applications.

All the necessary internal infrastructure including the electrical substation, roads, drainage and common facilities were provided by the Telangana State Industrial Infrastructure Corporation. The price of the land parcels was subsidised by a whopping 50%! Direct access road from the Outer Ring Road was provided to improve accessibility.

The FIP committee members - Jyotsna Angara, Ajita Reddy and Vani Subhas - were proactive in facilitating and addressing any concerns and queries that arose - from the project proposal stage to the commissioning of the factory. They liaised between the industry-owners and TSIIC when needed for smooth completion of the projects.

On July 6th, 2018, FLO Hyderabad and TSIIC allocated Allotment Letters to 18 FLO women entrepreneurs to set up their units in the FLO TSIIC Industrial Park, Sultanpur, Hyderabad, in the presence of Chief Guest Sri KT Rama Rao, Hon'ble Minister for IT, Industries & Commerce, Sri Rashesh Shah, President FICCI, Ms. Pinky Reddy, President FLO, Sri Jayesh Ranjan, Principal Secretary, Industries & Commerce, and Sri Narasimha Reddy, MD of TSIIC. The Hon'ble Minister, in his keynote address, promised to allocate substantial additional land to FLO as Phase 2 of the Industrial Park. The Minister was very appreciative of the various processes that FLO followed to allocate land to prospective applicants, including the governance process.

The allottees, cumulatively, brought in an Initial Investment of INR 250 Crs. with a projected potential of generating large-scale employment of over 1500, of which close to 55% would be women. Envisaged as a Green Category industrial zone, the current allottees belong to: Packaging, Organic Handloom Apparel, Electronics & Electricals, Food Processing, Medical Devices, Furniture, General Engineering, Metal Powders etc.

FLO Industrial Park was formally inaugurated on March 8, 2022 in the presence of then IT, Industries & Commerce Minister, Sri KT Rama Rao, Principal Secretary, Sri Jayesh Ranjan, FLO President Ujjwala Singhania, FLO Hyderabad Chairperson Uma Chigurupati, FLO Past President Kavitha Dutt, the FIP committee of Jyotsna Angara, Ajita Reddy, Vani Subhas and a host of other dignitaries.

Fruition of this ambitious project would not be possible without the contributions of many at FICCI & FLO, especially the core team led by Past FLO Presidents Kavitha Dutt and Pinky Reddy.

In September 2024, Innomet Advanced Materials went in for an SME IPO, which was oversubscribed 283 times. FLO Hyderabad is proud of this success story emerging from FLO Industrial Park, and hopes for many more to follow.

FIP is today reckoned as a role model for other women organisations to follow. Various national and international Business Delegations have visited FIP to observe and learn from the experience. In 2024 itself, delegations from Philippines and Rhineland-Palatinate visited FLO Industrial Park and interacted with the team behind the Park and the management leads of the companies in the Park.

Encouraged by the success of FIP, Sultanpur, Hyderabad, FLO is working towards duplicating the model across various chapters, and also pioneering the concept of integrated business townships linked to the Industrial parks.


# CATALYSING GROWTH THROUGH PARTNERSHIPS

October 5, 2024


The virtual launch of MIRAAS – The Festive Edit Catalogue was a vibrant celebration of India's rich handloom and handicraft heritage.










# FLO DIGITAL SKILLING INITIATIVE



The technical aspects of listing were covered by NSE's Senior Manager, Mr. Senthilmurugan R, while CA Gaurav Jain from Expert Global Consultants offered insights on the role of merchant bankers in IPO structuring.

The event highlighted NSE Emerge as a vital platform for SMEs seeking capital for growth, inspiring FLO members to explore public listing as a strategic pathway. The session was expertly coordinated by MSME Assist Cell head Neha Reddy, with team support from Soumyaa Rao.

#### **FLO HYDERABAD**
